Pilot Trial Underway to Assess the Effect of Web-Based Continuing Education on Integrative Medicine Approaches to Prostate Cancer

The University of Arizona Center for Integrative Medicine is offering a Web-Based Training with 7 hours of free CE Credit to Georgia Oncologists, Urologists, Primary Care Physicians and Nurse Navigators, as part of a pilot trial to assess the effect of web-based continuing education on integrative approaches to prostate cancer. Participants will take the 7 hour program in convenient segments over an 8 week period via the web and participate in pre and post assessments to determine changes in knowledge, beliefs and clinical practice.

ACS-Funded Time to Treatment Study Seeks to Enroll Caregivers and Patients

The American Cancer Society (ACS) has funded Emory University's Rollins School of Public Health (RSPH) to conduct a study to examine the effects of the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act of 2000 (BCCPTA) in Georgia on differences in the likelihood and timing of enrollment by race/ethnicity and, in turn, differences in the time to treatment for women of different racial/ethnic backgrounds.
