Georgia receives significant NCI funding for statewide research initiatives

Earlier this month, the National Cancer Institute announced that two Georgia-based consortiums have won millions of dollars in grants. The winners are formed collaborations of several institutions throughout the state that will lead NCI's Community Oncology Research Program (NCORP) in their respective communities.

The award winners are a consortium led by Georgia Regents University Cancer Center in Augusta and a statewide partnership, named "Georgia NCORP," made up of Atlanta's Northside Hospital Cancer Institute, Savannah's St. Joseph's/Candler's Nancy N. and J.C. Lewis Cancer and Research Pavilion, and Georgia CORE. Georgia CORE's affiliates in this endeavor are Harbin Clinic in Rome, John B. Amos Cancer Center in Columbus, Medical Center of Central Georgia in Macon and Northeast Georgia Medical Center in Gainesville. The Georgia NCORP award alone is \$5.85 million over five years, providing Georgians with 110 oncology clinical providers in 41 different locations throughout the state. Read more.
