Winship announces its participation in an \$11 Million Co-Hort Study on Cancer Survivorship

The **Winship Cancer Institute of Emory University** announces its participation in an \$11 million grant from the National Cancer Institute (NCI) that is one of the first of its kind for developing the infrastructure to study cancer survivorship. The 5-year grant will support a cohort study designed to identify factors that improve lymphoma survivors' length of life and quality-of-life. The principal investigators on the study are **Christopher Flowers, MD**, director of the Emory Lymphoma Program and associate professor in the Department of Hematology and Oncology, and **James Cerhan, MD**, professor of epidemiology and chair of the Department of Health Sciences Research at the Mayo Clinic.
